



AI TOPICS Top Themes by total thoughts








AI TOPICS Top Themes by total thoughts




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AI TOPICS Top Themes by star score

THOUGHTS Academic guidance



Five week marking periods at the Middle School are too short.

This change, to support shorter elective blocks, reduces opportunities for a balance period of assessments and uneven assessment opportunities.

Excelling students need more guidance and mentorship

They're often assumed to be doing well and so neglected, more interest and direction could make a large difference to them

I feel like there could be more guidance for high school students and their families on college prep starting sooner than junior year.

There is no guidance on when to start the process (PSATs, SAT, ACT testing) before junior year and I think that put us at a disadvantage and behind.

Eight marking periods is not beneficial to students, please revert back the standard quarter system.

The five week span is too narrow and puts unneeded stress on kids if they miss school or do poorly on a single assignment

Five week marking periods at the Middle School are too short.
